Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

August 25, 2024

Dear Parishioners,

On August 29th, the Church remembers **The Martyrdom of St John the Baptist**. From Pope Benedict XVI's address on August 29, 2012, entitled "**With love there is no compromise**" - "With love for Christ, for his Word, for Truth, there are no compromises. This is what we learn from St John the Baptist, martyred for 'his fidelity to God's commandments, without giving in or drawing back, carrying out his mission to the very end'....John the Baptist did not limit himself to teaching repentance or conversion. Instead, in recognizing Jesus as the 'Lamb of God' who came to take away the sin of the world (Jn 1:29), he had the profound humility to hold up Jesus as the One sent by God, drawing back so that he might take the lead, and be heard and followed. As his last act the Baptist witnessed with his blood to faithfulness to God's commandments, without giving in or withdrawing, carrying out his mission to the very end. In the 9th century the Venerable Bede says in one of his Homilies: 'St John gave his life for Christ. He was not ordered to deny Jesus Christ, but was ordered to keep silent about the truth'. And he did not keep silent about the truth and thus died for Christ who is the Truth. Precisely for love of the truth he did not stoop to compromises and did not fear to address strong words to anyone who had strayed from God's path. We see this great figure, this force in the Passion, in resistance to the powerful. We wonder: what gave birth to this life, to this interiority so strong, so upright, so consistent, spent so totally for God in preparing the way for Jesus? The answer is simple: it was born from the relationship with God, from prayer, which was the thread that guided him throughout his existence...John the Baptist, however, is not only a man of prayer, in permanent contact with God, but also a guide in this relationship...celebrating the martyrdom of St John the Baptist reminds us too, Christians of this time, that with love for Christ, for his words and for the Truth, we cannot stoop to compromises. The Truth is Truth; there are no compromises. Christian life demands, so to speak, the 'martyrdom' of daily fidelity to the Gospel, the courage, that is, to let Christ grow within us and let him be the One who guides our thought and our actions. However, this

can happen in our life only if we have a solid relationship with God. Prayer is not time wasted, it does not take away time from our activities, even apostolic activities, but exactly the opposite is true: only if we are able to have a faithful, constant and trusting life of prayer will God himself give us the ability and strength to live happily and serenely, to surmount difficulties and to witness courageously to him. **St John the Baptist, intercede for us, that we may be ever able to preserve the primacy of God in our life.**" God Bless!

HIS EUCHARISTIC CHALLENGE

“Jesus was fully aware that His disciples were murmuring in protest at what He had said. ‘Does it shake your faith?’ He asked them.” —John 6:61

Jesus challenges us to believe His mysterious statement: “The bread I will give is My flesh, for the life of the world” (Jn 6:51). A typical reaction to this challenge is to ask the question: “How can He give us His flesh to eat?” (Jn 6:52) Jesus does not directly answer this question. Rather, He extends an even more puzzling challenge by repeatedly insisting that we eat His Flesh and drink His Blood (Jn 6:53-58). If we do this, He will raise us from the dead (Jn 6:53-54), live in us and we in Him (Jn 6:56), and give us life forever (Jn 6:58). If we do not eat His Body and drink His Blood, we “have no life in” us (Jn 6:53).

Then “many of His disciples remarked, ‘This sort of talk is hard to endure! How can anyone take it seriously?’ ” (Jn 6:60) “From this time on, many of His disciples broke away and would not remain in His company any longer” (Jn 6:66). Nevertheless, Jesus continues to insist that we believe in and receive His Body and Blood.

Joshua challenged the people: “Decide today whom you will serve” (Jos 24:15). Jesus, the new Joshua (Jeshua), also challenges us to decide today about living to receive His Body and Blood. Will we receive Him in repentance, joy, and love? Will we receive Holy Communion as often as possible and center our lives on the Eucharist? Jesus is challenging us. Our actions will speak louder than our words. Will we accept Jesus’ challenge?

Prayer: Father, grant me the grace to come to the Eucharistic Jesus (see Jn 6:65).

Promise: “Defer to one another out of reverence for Christ.” —Eph 5:21

Praise: Praise You, risen Lord Jesus. You are holy and all your ways are true (see Tb 3:2).

XXI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

25 de Agosto, 2024

Queridos feligreses,

El 29 de agosto, la Iglesia recuerda **El martirio de San Juan Bautista**. Del discurso del Papa Benedicto XVI el 29 de agosto de 2012, titulado “**Con amor no hay compromiso**” - “*Con amor a Cristo, a su Palabra, a la Verdad, no hay compromisos. Esto es lo que aprendemos de San Juan Bautista, martirizado por 'su fidelidad a los mandamientos de Dios, sin ceder ni retroceder, cumpliendo con su misión hasta el final' ... Juan el Bautista no se limitó a enseñar el arrepentimiento o la conversión. En cambio, al reconocer a Jesús como el 'Cordero de Dios' que vino a quitar el pecado del mundo (Jn 1:29), tuvo la profunda humildad de presentar a Jesús como el enviado de Dios, retrocediendo para que él pudiera tomar la iniciativa y ser escuchado y seguido. Como último acto, el Bautista testificó con su sangre la fidelidad a los mandamientos de Dios, sin ceder ni retraerse, cumpliendo su misión hasta el final. En el siglo IX, el Venerable Beda dice en una de sus Homilías: 'San Juan dio su vida por Cristo. No se le ordenó negar a Jesucristo, sino que se le ordenó guardar silencio sobre la verdad'. Y no guardó silencio sobre la verdad y así murió por Cristo que es la Verdad. Precisamente por amor a la verdad, no se rebajó a compromisos y no temió dirigir palabras duras a cualquiera que se hubiera desviado del camino de Dios. Vemos esta gran figura, esta fuerza en la Pasión, en resistencia a lo poderoso. Nos preguntamos: ¿qué dio origen a esta vida, a esta interioridad tan fuerte, tan recta, tan coherente, entregada totalmente a Dios preparando el camino de Jesús? La respuesta es simple: nació de la relación con Dios, de la oración, que fue el hilo que lo guió a lo largo de su existencia... Juan el Bautista, sin embargo, no es solo un hombre de oración, en contacto permanente con Dios, sino también un guía en esta relación... celebrar el martirio de San Juan Bautista nos recuerda también a nosotros, cristianos de este tiempo, que con amor a Cristo, a sus palabras y a la Verdad, no podemos rebajarnos a compromisos. La verdad es verdad; no hay compromisos. La vida cristiana exige, por así decirlo, el 'martirio' de la fidelidad diaria al Evangelio, es decir, la valentía de dejar crecer a Cristo en nosotros y que sea él quien guie nuestro pensamiento y nuestras acciones. Sin embargo, esto puede suceder en nuestra vida solo si tenemos una relación sólida con Dios. La oración*

no es una pérdida de tiempo, no quita tiempo a nuestras actividades, incluso a las apostólicas, sino todo lo contrario: sólo si somos capaces de tener una vida de oración fiel, constante y confiada, Dios mismo nos dará la capacidad y fuerza para vivir feliz y seriamente, superar las dificultades y testimoniarle valientemente. San Juan Bautista, intercede por nosotros, para que podamos conservar siempre la primacía de Dios en nuestra vida”. ¡Dios los bendiga!

SU RETO EUCARÍSTICO

“Jesús, sabiendo lo que Sus discípulos murmuraban, les dijo: ‘¿Esto los escandaliza?’” (Juan 6:61)

Jesús nos desafía a creer en Su misteriosa declaración: “El pan que Yo daré es Mi carne para la vida del mundo” (Jn 6:51). Una reacción típica ante tal desafío es hacer la pregunta: “¿Cómo este hombre puede darnos a comer Su carne?” (Jn 6:52) Jesús no responde directamente a esta pregunta. Más bien, Él plantea un desafío aún más desconcertante al insistir repetidamente en que comamos Su Carne y bebamos Su Sangre (Jn 6:53-58). Si hacemos esto, Él nos resucitará de entre los muertos (Jn 6:53-54), vivirá en nosotros y nosotros en Él (Jn 6:56) y nos dará vida para siempre (Jn 6:58). “Si no comen la carne del Hijo del Hombre y no beben Su sangre, “no tendrán vida en ustedes” (Jn 6:53).

Entonces, “después de oírlo, muchos de Sus discípulos decían: ‘¡Es duro este lenguaje! ¿Quién puede escucharlo?’” (Jn 6:60) “Desde ese momento, muchos de Sus discípulos se alejaron de Él y dejaron de acompañarlo” (Jn 6:66). Sin embargo, Jesús continúa insistiendo en que creamos y recibamos Su Cuerpo y Sangre.

Josué desafió al pueblo: “Elijan hoy a quién quieren servir” (Jos 24:15). Jesús, el nuevo Josué (Jeshua), también nos desafía a decidir hoy sobre vivir para recibir Su Cuerpo y Sangre. ¿Lo recibiremos con arrepentimiento, gozo y amor? ¿Recibiremos la Sagrada Comunión con la mayor frecuencia posible y centraremos nuestras vidas en la Eucaristía? Jesús nos está desafiando. Nuestras acciones hablarán más que nuestras palabras. ¿Aceptaremos el desafío de Jesús?

Oración: Padre, concédemme la gracia de venir a Jesús Eucarístico (ver Jn 6:65).

Promesa: “Sométanse los unos a otros por consideración a Cristo” (Ef 5:21).

Alabanza: Alabado seas, Señor Jesús resucitado. Tú eres santo y todos tus caminos son verdaderos (ver Tob 3:2).






Saints Monica and Augustine August 27 and 28


HER SON AUGUSTINE, HOWEVER, WAS AWAY LIVING A LIFE OF SIN AND DISSIPATION.




AUGUSTINE WAS VERY SMART BUT STUBBORN. MONICA PRAYED AND WEPT FOR HIM.




