Dear Parishioners,

A few weeks ago, our Finance Council met to approve the **Annual Financial Report** for our Parish. I have attached the report to the back of this bulletin. Our offertory collections have increased, which I am very pleased with. Our "Total Income" ("Gross Profit") has increased by about \$14,000, although the majority of that increase was attributable to a one-time donation from a parishioner of \$8,000. Our expenses have decreased by about \$500, which is also good news. Even though the overall numbers are encouraging for our parish, we still could use an increase of financial support from every parishioner. Our Masses are *not* regularly attended well, and we are just bringing in over \$3,000 on the weekends between the four Masses. With this in mind, **I would like to encourage every family in our parish to pray about giving more to the parish.**

Thankfully, a lot of work has been done by parishioners giving of their "time" and "talent" to the parish, whether it be the mowing of the front lawn, the constant care of the grounds, the floor of the Church being polished, a Church radiator being fixed as well as a leaky boiler, the painting of the St. Therese statue in the Church as well as the painting of the areas by the Church windows. We are starting to address a few repairs, with the windows in the Parish Hall, as well as some leaks on the roof of the Rectory and the area where the Rectory and Church roofs meet. The majority of our bills has to do with simply running our facilities. As we approach the great feast of Thanksgiving, I want to especially thank the Lord for each one of you, and especially for the ways in which you have contributed your "time, talent, and treasure" to our parish. As a parish family, may we continue to pray for, and encourage one another in the Faith. God Bless!

“ONE THING”

“There is one thing more you must do.” —

Mark 10:21

In today’s Gospel passage, a rich man asked what he must do to share in eternal life (Mk 10:17). He had done much, but Jesus told him to do “one thing more” (Mk 10:21). That was the one thing standing between himself and the eternal life he desired. That one thing more was to sell what he possessed, give the proceeds to the poor, and follow Jesus (Mk 10:21). This the rich man could not do and he “went away sad” (Mk 10:22).

Through His Word, God has given us much wisdom (Wis 7:7-11) to know what our one thing might be. It behooves us, then, to be grounded in the Word of God. God’s Word is alive (Heb 4:12). The Word convicts us (Heb 4:12-13) and brings constantly to our mind that one thing more God wants us to yield to Him.

Mary of Bethany found the one thing Jesus wanted her to do: to sit at His feet and listen to His Word (see Lk 10:39). Jesus approved Mary’s action and confirmed it by saying: “one thing only is required” (Lk 10:42).

“One thing I ask of the Lord; this I seek: to dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, that I may gaze on the loveliness of the Lord and contemplate His temple” (Ps 27:4). Give Jesus that one thing that separates you from following Him completely.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, take not just one thing from me, but take everything. Give me only Your love and Your grace.

Promise: “All gold, in view of [Wisdom], is a little sand, and before her, silver is to be accounted mire.” —Wisdom 7:9

Praise: Risen Jesus, praise be to You, my God and my All.

Queridos feligreses,

Hace unas semanas, nuestro Consejo de Finanzas se reunió para aprobar el Informe Financiero Anual de nuestra Parroquia. He adjuntado el informe al final de este boletín. Nuestras colectas para el ofertorio han aumentado, lo que me complace mucho. Nuestro "Ingreso Total" ("Ganancia Bruta") ha aumentado en aproximadamente \$14,000, aunque la mayor parte de ese aumento fue atribuible a una donación única de un feligrés de \$8,000. Nuestros gastos disminuyeron en aproximadamente \$500, lo que también es una buena noticia. Aunque las cifras generales son alentadoras para nuestra parroquia, aún necesitamos un aumento del apoyo financiero de cada feligrés. Nuestras Misas no reciben mucha asistencia regularmente y apenas recaudamos más de \$3,000 los fines de semana entre las cuatro Misas. Con esto en mente, **me gustaría alentar a cada familia de nuestra parroquia a orar para dar más a la parroquia.**

Afortunadamente, los feligreses han hecho mucho trabajo al dar su "tiempo" y "talento" a la parroquia, ya sea cortar el césped del frente de la iglesia, cuidar constantemente los jardines, pulir el piso de la iglesia, arreglar un radiador de la iglesia y una caldera que gotea, pintar la estatua de Santa Teresita en la iglesia y pintar las áreas junto a las ventanas de la iglesia. Estamos comenzando a abordar algunas reparaciones, en las ventanas del salón parroquial, así como algunas goteras en el techo de la rectoría y en el área donde se unen los techos de la rectoría y la iglesia. La mayoría de nuestras facturas tienen que ver simplemente con el funcionamiento de nuestras instalaciones. Al acercarnos a la gran fiesta de Acción de Gracias, quiero agradecer especialmente al Señor por cada uno de ustedes, y especialmente por las formas en que han contribuido con su "tiempo, talento y tesoro" a nuestra parroquia. Como familia parroquial, sigamos orando y animándonos unos a otros en la fe. ¡Dios los bendiga!

“UNA SÓLA COSA”

“Solo te falta una cosa” (Marcos 10:21). hacer para heredar la vida eterna (Marcos 10:17). Este hombre ya había hecho mucho, pero Jesús le dijo que le faltaba una cosa (Mc 10:21). Eso era lo único que se interponía entre él y la vida eterna que deseaba. Esa cosa que aún le faltaba no era sino vender todo lo que poseía, y entregar el dinero a los pobres para seguir a Jesús (Mc 10:21). Sin embargo, el hombre rico no quiso hacerlo, “se entristeció y se fue apeñado” (Mc 10:22).

Por medio de su palabra, Dios nos ha dado mucha sabiduría (Sab 7:7-11) para que nos percatemos de cuál es esa cosa que nos falta a nosotros. Conviene, pues, que estemos muy familiarizados con la palabra de Dios. La palabra de Dios está viva (Heb 4:12) y nos declara dónde está nuestra culpa (Heb 4:12-13). Nos recuerda constantemente qué es eso que Dios nos pide y nos negamos a dársela.

María de Betania pronto encontró aquello que Jesús le pedía: sentarse a Sus pies y escuchar Su palabra (ver Lc 10:39). Jesús ratificó que María hacía bien en quedarse a Sus pies cuando dijo: “solo una cosa es necesaria” (Lc 10:42).

“Una sola cosa he pedido al Señor, y esto es lo que quiero: vivir en la Casa del Señor todos los días de mi vida, para gozar de la dulzura del Señor y contemplar Su Templo” (Sal 27:4). Entrégale a Jesús esa cosa que te está separando de seguirlo completamente y sin reservas.

Oración: Señor Jesús, no tomes de mí una cosa solamente; tómallo todo. Dame solo Tu amor y gracia.

Promesa: “No la igualé (la sabiduría) a la piedra más preciosa, porque todo el oro,

comparado con ella, es un poco de arena; y la plata, a su lado, será considerada como barro” (Sab 7:9).

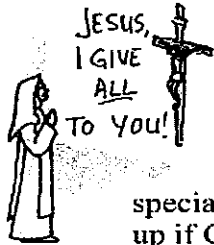
The rich man in today's Gospel reading wanted to follow Jesus. But he was sad when Jesus told him that he should sell his things and give his money to the poor.

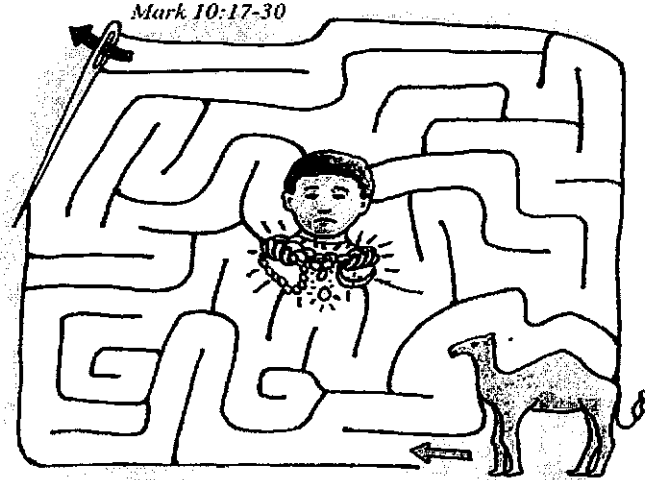

Did you hear about Elizabeth?

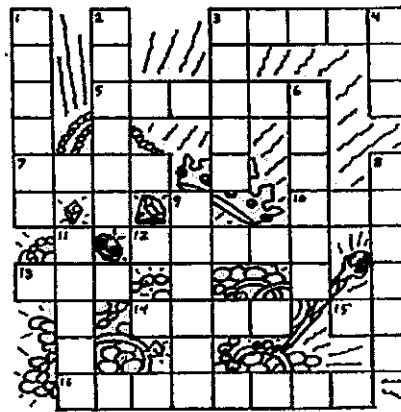
